Purpose:

1. To adopt the draft report of the sixth Waigani Convention Scientific and Technical Advisory Committee (STAC-6) meeting.

Background:

- 2. In its Decision WC1/5, the first meeting of the Conference of the Parties, established the Scientific and Technical Advisory Committee (STAC) as a subsidiary body to the Conference to meet as necessary to consider practicalities of implementation, legal and technical issues as mandated by the Conference of the Parties subject to the availability of funds.
- 3. The Conference requested the Secretariat to develop a TOR for the STAC which was considered and approved in its Decision WC/2/I, thus formalising the working group. The meetings of the STAC are held inter-sessionally between COP meetings and as required, the meeting reports are to be presented to the COP meeting for formal adoption.
- 4. The STAC has meet a total of 6 times as shown in the table below:
