The Secretariat of the Pacific Regional Environment Programme (SPREP), through the 'Committing to Sustainable Waste Actions in the Pacific' (SWAP) Project is pleased to launch the four (4) Open-learning Courses on Waste Management now available on the PCCC e-learning Moodle platform.

This training is a core activity of the Capacity Building on Sustainable Waste Management components of the SWAP Project. The training program has been developed by CIFAL Newcastle in collaboration with University of Newcastle and Asia Pacific Waste Consultants, and is designed to:

- improve and enhance waste management activities in the capacity of governments, industry, and communities to manage waste to reduce the impact on human health and the environment;
- improve sanitation, environmental, social, and economic conditions in Pacific Island countries
 and territories through proper waste management with the focus on four areas: Project
 Management (Module 1), Used Oil Management (Module 3), Disaster Waste Management
 (Module 4), and an overarching issue on Sustainable Financing mechanisms for waste
 management (Module 2); and
- strengthen communities and local authorities' capacity in the areas of technical waste management, institutional governance, and finance.
