**Subject: Request for tenders (RFT): Manufacturing and Delivery of Signages for 25 Communal Compost across nine provinces in Fiji.**

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1. How will we mount the Facility Signboard? Do we need to provide poles for it as well?

- PacWastePlus has engaged a contractor to install the printed signs. This contract is looking for a company to only print and deliver signs to the respective Provincial Council Office.

2. For the Notice Boards, Will it mounted on the wall or do we need to provide stands of it as well

- Companies are not expected to provide stands. PacWaste Plus has engaged a contractor to handle the installation. This contract is specifically for printing and delivery of printed signs and Notice Board.

3. Upon reviewing the tender request, I noticed that you have specified the use of timber frames for the signboards. However, considering that these signboards are to be installed on islands near the sea, I would like to suggest the use of galvanized steel frames instead. Galvanized steel offers superior resistance to corrosion, particularly in coastal environments where saltwater and humidity can cause rapid degradation of materials. This would ensure the longevity and durability of the signboards, reducing the need for frequent maintenance or replacement.

I believe this adjustment would provide a more practical and long-lasting solution, given the challenging environmental conditions.
