Subject: Request for tenders (RFT): Supply & delivery of an industrial baler/compactor to process household recyclable items on Funafuti, Tuvalu

Question 1:

Are you looking for a vertical baler?

Response:

No preference – seek for equipment to fit with power supply requirements and process recyclable items to enable size reduction and packaging for export.

Question 2:

Are the vehicles you are referring to bicycles or other?

Response:

Yes "vehicles" would refer to small motorbikes etc or vehicle parts appropriate for baling. Note: Priority is for baler/compactor to manage the ~5 tonne/week of clean household recyclable items (PET, aluminium, etc). Ability to also bale/compact other products such as scrap metal from end-of-life whiteware and vehicle parts seen as a bonus for equipment

Question 3:

Does the machine need to be able to press the whole bikes?

Response:

Not necessarily - ability to also bale/compact other products such as scrap metal from end-of-life whiteware and vehicles seen as a bonus for equipment

Any idea for percentage of these plastic, paper, metal scrap for the 5T/Week?
